

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1150 # 3

DIGEST

Abandoned storage vehicles. Provides that the costs for storage of an abandoned vehicle with a length of at least 30 feet may not exceed \$5,000.

- 1 Page 2, after line 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 2. IC 9-22-1-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.157-2017,
3 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 4. (a) Except as provided in subsection ~~(c)~~; **(d)**,
5 the owner of an abandoned vehicle or parts is:
6 (1) responsible for the abandonment; and
7 (2) liable for all of the costs incidental to the removal, storage,
8 and disposal;
9 of the vehicle or the parts under this chapter.
10 **(b) Except as provided in subsection (c)**, the costs for storage of
11 an abandoned vehicle may not exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000).
12 **(c) The costs for storage of an abandoned vehicle with a length**
13 **of at least thirty (30) feet may not exceed five thousand dollars**
14 **(\$5,000).**
15 ~~(c)~~ **(d)** If an abandoned vehicle is sold by a person who removed,
16 towed, or stored the vehicle, the person who previously owned the
17 vehicle is not responsible for storage fees.
18 ~~(d)~~ **(e)** If an abandoned vehicle is sold by a person who removed,
19 towed, or stored the vehicle, and proceeds from the sale of the vehicle
20 covered the removal, towing, sale disposal, and storage expenses, any
21 remaining proceeds from the sale of the vehicle shall be returned as
22 described in this chapter or IC 9-22-6, whichever is applicable."
23 Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
