I want to personally wish you all a wonderful New Year, and say thank you for making 2020 a success for ITWA.





DOT CHAT



Hello and welcome back! If you are new to the column I would like to take a minute and bring you up to speed on who I am. My name is Brent Hoover. I am a Master Trooper with the Indiana State Police. October marked my 16th year with the ISP. I am assigned to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division or CVED for short. My primary daily duty is to enforce the State and Federal Regulations for CMVs in the State of Indiana. I am certified to complete Part A and B Inspections, as well as General Haz-mat and Cargo Tank inspections. I am also a Part B Instructor for the National Training Center, which means I teach new inspectors how to inspect and document Level 1 Inspections. I have competed twice in the North American Inspectors Championships. I am the current administrator of the CVED Facebook page where I post about tips and tricks to improve your pre-trip inspections and to avoid common roadside violations.

This month marks the final month of 2020....shhhew....We made it!!!! This month's question is about apportion plates and when you need them. The question was, "Can you do a long-distance tow on just a standard plate?" Not without a little extra. See below. Jfa-0308

What is IRP?

The International Registration Plan (IRP) is a cooperative registration agreement between the United States and Canada for payment of license fees based on the total distance operated in all jurisdictions.

IRP makes licensing easy by allowing license fees to be distributed to multiple areas where fleet vehicles are operated with only one license plate and one cab card needed for each vehicle.

Commercial motor vehicles weighing more than 26,000 lbs. or having more than two axles (either alone or in combination) and traveling into more than one jurisdiction are likely registered under IRP. Without this type of plate, they do not have reciprocity to travel into neighboring areas and would need to obtain a temporary registration permit to travel outside their home area.

So, if you exceed this requirement then you need to have an IRP Plate or a Temp Permit for the trip.

December 12, 2020, via Zoom.

Meeting was called to order by Karrie Driscol at 1:00 pm.

2019 Annual Minutes were Approved – Motioned by Walt Hamilton and seconded by Jim Steele.

Secretary-Treasurer Report was read and distributed by Walt Hamilton. Current assets \$158,021.82. Motion to approve by Jim Steele and seconded by Karrie Driscol.

President Report was presented by Sue Moreland. Issues we worked on include calendars, overweight issues, training, annual meeting, tow show and membership. Sue also expressed thanks to all who helped with funeral processions for Sam and Paul. As we go through the agenda, we will discuss most of these items in more detail.

The Legislative Preview was presented by Bart Giesler. The session begins in January. This will be a budget session and will be a long one. This is also a redistricting year. There was talk of COVID liability relief for business owners. Bart, Sue Moreland and Josh Hercamp spoke with INDOT about overweight issue; however they were not very receptive to an overweight exception for tow operators. Ultimately, the legislature was not even lukewarm to the idea. The main opposition is that milk trucks have dedicated routes and due to the nature of our business that is not an option for us. Task force on these issues is led by Jim Prussel. Josh Hercamp, Sue Moreland and Bart Giesler will discuss further options. Ken Parrish asked about exception to longer than 50 mile rule, but there is nothing black or white.

The 2020/2021 Christmas Party was presented by Crystal Rose. Due to COVID concerns, the 2020 Christmas Party was cancelled. The photographer we had did not charge us to cancel and the deposit we paid to Fair Oaks will be applied to the 2021 Tow Show. The 2021 Christmas Party will be held Dec. 11, 2021 at Fair Oaks Farms.

The Training Committee was presented by Ken Parrish and Joseph Driscol. Casey Burrows is willing to put on association classes. Classes are a good place for recruitment into the ITWA. There was discussion about a \$100.00 driver member/supporting member. The member may not be an owner, is eligible for the survivor fund as a member and for life insurance benefit, and any member discounts for training. Motion made by Ken Parrish and seconded by Joseph Driscol.

Wreckmaster would like to put on a class at the 2021 Tow Show. Training is scheduled to take place on Saturday from 8 am to 3:30 pm for the indoor training and the same hours on Sunday for the outdoor portion. Wreckmaster will be heading to all web based training in the future. There will be a TIMs class held on Friday night at Fair Oaks at the Tow Show.

Crystal presented the Website update. The website is really close to going live and there will be news, events, advertisements, and account benefits of being a member, as well as an online store to purchase items. There will be a member only section that will have the newsletter each month and member only information.

2021 ideas were presented by Sue Moreland. The ideas are that we all come up with 2 or 3 names from our area and get those names to Sue and Bart so that they can reach out to people.

There was a motion made to discount the 1st year of membership dues to \$250.00 by Walt Hamilton and seconded by Karrie Driscol. The motion carried.

The 2021 Tow Show will take place again at Fair Oaks Farms. Sue and Crystal are looking to put a tow show committee together and will be looking for volunteers. The tow show for 2021 will be held 08/06/2021 thru 08/08/2021. Rooms are available for \$149.00 per night for a double and they have 99 rooms available. After that, the Baymont Inn and Comfort Suites at exit 215 will be taking the overflow. We will be looking into a shuttle service, if needed, for transportation to Baymont and Comfort Suites. We will be in a different parking lot closer to the building this year and we will have the grassy area as well, just outside the ball room. Saturday will be a silent auction. Saturday will be the Wreckmaster indoor portion, as well as the ladies luncheon. Sunday will be the outdoor portion of Wreckmaster training. They are looking at having kids' activities in the grassy area outdoors and maybe a movie night for kids. Pat Winer is willing to do the rotator challenges again this year. Friday night will be a street party.

Waffco trailer is at Joey's Enterprise lot and needs to be gone through to see what can be used for the 2021 Tow Show.

Open discussion was held by Sue Moreland. There was a motion to carry over the officers from 2020 into 2021, as they are, by Walt Hamilton and seconded by Mark Miller. That motion carried. This motion was previously made at the previous board meeting, but since this was the Annual Meeting, it was made again to be in compliance with the By-Laws. There was discussion of trying to get members to pay dues sooner by actively changing the password to the ITWA Website so that people are paying for access. This was going to be looked into to see how easy that was.

Ken Parrish suggested for future raffles to raffle a custom raffle. After discussion, the Board needed more information on the legality through the gaming commission, as well as the liability of the association. At the next board meeting, the issue will be discussed.


