FROM THE DESK OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR BART GIESLER

Each legislative session is different and this year is no exception. The session “lost” a week of work when there were reports of possible violent protests at Statehouses across the country. There have been legislators and staff test positive from COVID and not been able to go to the Statehouse. Full-time staff and interns are working split shifts at the Statehouse as a precautionary measure. The House has moved their chambers and most of their committee rooms into the Government Center. As a result, they are able to have less committee hearings and because of this, less bills will make it to the floor for debate. The Senate has committee members in one committee room and the public testify via zoom in another room.

Even with all these changes, ITWA is having a great start to the session that ends by the end of April. HB 1150 was amended by Rep. Bob Morris (R- Ft. Wayne) to increase the maximum storage charge for trucks over 30 feet from \$2,000 to \$2,500. This bill has passed and is awaiting action by the Senate. ITWA does not expect the Senate to take up action on the bill until early March, when they start discussing House bills. ITWA wants to thank Rep. Morris for amending HB 1150 in committee, and we also want to thank Parker Wrecker Service for contacting Rep. Morris and educating him on the issue. I have encouraged everyone to contact their legislator and develop a relationship. I think this clearly shows that legislators are willing to listen and help where they can. At the request of ITWA, Rep. Doug Miller from Elkhart amended HB 1498 to give towing companies the “government rate” for newspaper ads that are required to advertise that cars will be sold or auctioned. Newspapers charge different rates across the state and in some cases, ads are as high as \$80 plus for one car. In other places, ads are as little as \$5 per car. If you have any examples of high rates, please share those with us.

Based on information she received attending one of our Chapter meetings in Bloomington, Rep. Peggy Mayfield (Martinsville) has included a provision in HB 1377 dealing with multiple BMV issues. One of the provisions requires the BMV to include “proper procedures to yield the right of way or reduce speed under IC 9-21-8-35” (Move Over Law). ITWA will work with the author and committee chair to see if we can get a hearing on the bill.

Session is dynamic – so by the time you receive this newsletter, things have changed. As a result, we have added a link to the website to get real time updates on all bills we are tracking. Please take time to contact your legislators to support these bills. We have the procedures online for you to find and contact your legislators.



BILLS OF INTEREST

Here is a partial list of bills of interest with an abbreviated digest. For a full list of bills, please go to the ITWA website:

HB 1150 - OVERWEIGHT DIVISIBLE LOADS - Provides that a person who transports a vehicle or combination of vehicles with an overweight divisible load is subject to overweight divisible load permitting. Provides that the department of transportation may not issue a permit for an overweight divisible load if the owner or operator of the vehicle has not provided the department of state revenue with full payment for the permit prior to transporting the overweight divisible load. Provides that the costs for storage of an abandoned vehicle with a length of at least 30 feet may not exceed \$2,500.

HB 1498 PUBLICATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT NOTICES - Allows a political subdivision to publish legal notices on a legal notice web site instead of in a newspaper. Provides that a towing service acting as an agent of a government agency that provides the notice required to dispose of abandoned vehicles or parts is subject to the same public notice advertising rates as a governmental agency.

HB 1377 BUREAU OF MOTOR VEHICLES - Requires a law enforcement agency that receives a notification of a stolen license plate to forward the notification to the bureau of motor vehicles (bureau). Requires the bureau to mark the license plate as stolen and not reissue the license plate. Requires the bureau to include procedures for: (1) approaching and driving through a roundabout; and (2) yielding the right-of-way to certain vehicles (Move Over Law); with standards for classroom and in-car driver education curriculum.

SB 1/ HB 1002 CIVIL IMMUNITY RELATED TO COVID-19 - Provides civil tort immunity for damages arising from COVID-19 on the premises owned or operated by a person, on any premises on which the person or an employee or agent of the person provided property or services to the individual, or during an activity managed, organized, or sponsored by the person, except for an act or omission that constitutes gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct (including fraud and intentionally tortious acts). Defines "COVID-19 protective product" and provides civil tort immunity for harm that results from the design, manufacture, labeling, sale, distribution, or donation of a COVID-19 protective product, except for an act or omission that constitutes gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct (including fraud and intentionally tortious acts). Prohibits class action suits.

SB 400 STATEWIDE ELECTRONIC LIEN AND TITLE SYSTEM - Requires the bureau of motor vehicles (bureau) to implement a statewide electronic lien (this lien is a financial lien – not a mechanic lien) and title system (system) to process: (1) vehicle titles; (2) certificate of title data in which a lien is notated; and (3) the notification, maintenance, and release of security interests in vehicles; through electronic means instead of paper documents.

All applications must be complete by 4 p.m. ET on Monday, Feb. 1. Incomplete permit applications and unpaid permits will not be moved to the new system; you will have to reapply for them on Feb. 8.

Customers can view, pay and print permits already in the system. Customers cannot apply for new permits.*

Important Deadlines and Information on Emergency OSW Permits

Transition Information

On Feb. 8, customers will start applying for OSW permits using a brand-new system that features new ways to input destinations and the option to choose a pre-approved route or one of the system's alternate routes to receive permits immediately.

To prepare for the new OSW permitting system, DOR and INDOT asks that customers take note of the following dates:

After 4 p.m. EST, Monday, Feb 1:

- The current OSW system will NOT accept new permit applications.
- Customers will need to reapply for incomplete permits in the new system starting Feb. 8.

After 4 p.m. EST, Monday, Feb 1, through Monday, Feb. 8:

- No new OSW permits will be issued except in the event of an emergency (see info on right).

After 4 p.m. EST, Monday, Feb. 1 through 4 p.m. EST on Thursday, Feb. 4

- Customers will only be able to view, pay and print permits already applied for in the current system.

Emergency Permit Information

Emergency permits will be issued subject to approval and require immediate payment (no escrow accounts) for the following reasons only:

- Unexpected equipment failure that will shut down a manufacturing process;
- Train derailment;
- Breakdown or threatened breakdown of electric, gas, water, or telephone public utility facilities; or
- In response to a situation that poses an immediate danger to life or health (e.g., a smokestack damaged by high winds is threatening to fall).

Allow additional time for emergency permits as routes will be developed manually.

DOT CHAT



Hello and welcome back! If you are new to the column, I would like to take a minute and bring you up to speed on who I am. My name is Brent Hoover. I am a Master Trooper with the Indiana State Police. October marked my 16th year with the ISP. I am assigned to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division or CVED for short. My primary daily duty is to enforce the State and Federal Regulations for CMVs in the State of Indiana. I am certified to complete Part A and B Inspections, as well as General Haz-mat and Cargo Tank inspections. I am also a Part B Instructor for the National Training Center, which means I teach new inspectors how to inspect and document Level 1 Inspections. I have competed twice in the North American Inspectors Championships. I am the current administrator of the CVED Facebook page where I post about tips and tricks to improve your pre-trip inspections and to avoid common roadside violations.

Welcome to 2021!!!! The New Year is an excellent time to rethink and reevaluate. I would like to take a few minutes and share something that we should all know.... Cell phone usage.

In July of 2020, the State of Indiana enacted a Hands-Free law. The law is posted below.

IC 9-21-8-59 Use of telecommunications device while operating a moving motor vehicle.

Sec. 59. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c), a person may not hold or use a telecommunications device while operating a moving motor vehicle.

- (b) A telecommunications device may be used in conjunction with hands free or voice operated technology.
- (c) A telecommunications device may be used or held to call 911 to report a bona fide emergency.

What I would like for tow operators to know is that they are not exempt under the law for normal driving and talking on the cell phone. I have personally seen several tow truck drivers in my area in violation. Not only is this now a law in Indiana but it is also a Federal law as well.

392.82 Using a hand-held mobile telephone.


- (a)(1) No driver shall use a hand-held mobile telephone while driving a CMV.
- (2) No motor carrier shall allow or require its drivers to use a hand-held mobile telephone while driving a CMV.

Companies and Drivers that are caught using a cell phone in a CMV can result in civil penalties to the company and the drivers. So please make sure that you are following these laws and regulations so that you can stay safe.
