FROM THE DESK OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR BART GIESLER

Here we go again...

A couple of months back, I received an old ITWA newsletter from April 2012 from Tom Bertagnolli where he wrote his monthly article for the *Hook & Winch*. His article focused on the high cost of diesel fuel (it was \$3.85 per the article compared to today's \$6.03 average). If you remember the high prices from 2012 (or the 2008 prices of \$4.60 per gallon), the good news is that you made it through. I am confident that we will make it through these high prices as well. I don't have any great advice other than the basics – tire pressure – maintenance – plan ahead.

I was contacted by Rep. Jim Pressel who chairs the House Roads and Transportation Committee. As a result of the various bills dealing with towing industry over the past couple of years, he is going to pull the various stakeholders (towing, insurance, banking, car dealers, BMV and others) together in August to see if there can be a comprehensive clean up legislation. If you have ideas, please let me or any of the ITWA directors and officers know your suggestions. As you consider ideas, think about what the biggest headaches are for you. What processes are cumbersome and don't add value? What can be streamlined? We need to remember that there are other groups at the table and we need to make sure that there are consumer protections. I don't know where the ad hoc group will end up, but do know that ITWA will be at the table. If we are professional and respectful of the process, this can be a positive opportunity for us. Part of the process is knowing your legislators. The legislature re-drew the maps in 2021 and this is the first general election with the new maps, so your legislators may have changed. There have also been several retirements, so please take the time to identify and meet with your legislators.

With the upcoming Tow Show, I want to once again remind everyone to sign up in advance for the Show. President Moreland has done an incredible job of getting vendors and sponsors to participate. The Tow Show committee also needs to plan the show – which includes figuring out how many meals are needed – how many people will be attending classes – and the list goes on and on. I also want to remind you to invite your local police and fire departments to attend the electric vehicle class (as well as the show). As an industry, we need to work hand in hand with the first responders. They need to know this information just as much as we do. If we ALL are on the same page, the safer it will be for everyone. The same is true for other towing companies. Please invite them, even if they are not part of ITWA. If they attend the class, they will see that ITWA responds to the needs of its members and they are more likely to join.

Please don't forget to send in your raffle tickets to ITWA or let us know if you will bring them to the show!

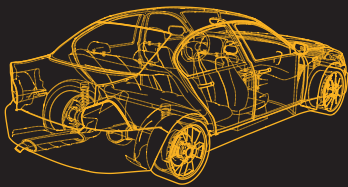

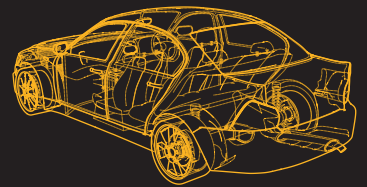

DOT CHAT WITH BRENT HOOVER



Hello and welcome back! If you are new to the column I would like to take a minute and bring you up to speed on who I am. My name is Brent Hoover. I am a Master Trooper with the Indiana State Police. October marked my 18th year with the ISP. I am assigned to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division or CVED for short. My primary daily duty is to enforce the State and Federal Regulations for CMVs in the State of Indiana. I am certified to complete Part A and B Inspections as well as General Haz-mat and Cargo Tank inspections. I am also a Part B Instructor for the National Training Center, which means I teach new inspectors how to inspect and document Level 1 inspections. I have competed twice in the North American Inspectors Championships. I am the current administrator of the CVED Facebook page where I post about tips and tricks to improve your pre-trip inspections and to avoid common roadside violations.

This month I would like to talk about pre -trip inspections and what you should be looking for and checking. So, we see that 396.11 covers:

396.11 Driver vehicle inspection report(s).

- (i) Service brakes including trailer brake connections;
- (ii) Parking brake;
- (iii) Steering mechanism;
- (iv) Lighting devices and reflectors;
- (v) Tires;
- (vi) Horn;
- (vii) Windshield wipers;
- (viii) Rear vision mirrors;
- (ix) Coupling devices;
- (x) Wheels and rims;
- (xi) Emergency equipment.

Are you taking the time to stop and thoroughly go through your truck before you head out on the road? Take a few minutes and remember back to your CDL test. When inspecting service brakes, don't forget to pump down your air brakes and check for the low air warning lights and buzzer, and to make sure that the valve pops out on its own. Do you know where your triangles and fire extinguisher are, and if your extinguisher is full? Take your time and check these items from time to time.

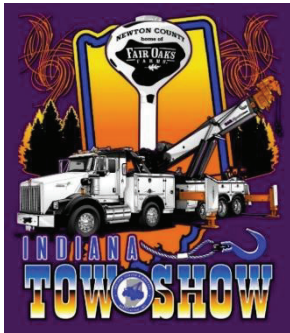
