5. WINDOWS (*Cracks, Chips*)
6. STATE ASSOCIATION STICKER/DECAL/PLATE
7. TOOL COMPARTMENT & TOOLS – (*Variety & Orderly*)
8. CABLE, HOOKS, SLING AND UNDER REACH, CHAINS – (*Condition*)
9. CHROME-LIGHTING
10. GLOVES/SAFETY VEST (5 Points each)
11. MEMBER OF ASSOCIATION
12. ENGINE COMPARTMENT
13. **EXTRA POINTS:** Judges can add points for optional equipment needed to do a safe and professional recovery job. Can add up to 20 points. (Sawzall, bolt cutters, chainsaw, wire cutters, etc.....) Judges can also subtract points for any unprofessional conduct of an entrant at the show.



2023 INDIANA TOW SHOW AT BOONE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

TOW TRUCK BEAUTY CONTEST RULES

1. Show truck contest entries **must be owned** and entered by towing companies and not exhibited by a towing equipment company or distributor. Trucks in exhibit area must have permanent lettering – **no magnetic signs or logos**. Show trucks must have a current registration. No Dealer Tags, Temporary Tags, or Special Plates will be permitted. The owner must show registration upon request. ITWA reserves the right to deny entry or remove a truck from the exhibit for any reason.
2. Show Trucks must be parked in the designated contest area prior to **11am Saturday** and remain there until 6pm. If trucks are parked anywhere other than the designated area, the location must be noted on the registration form.
3. A panel of 3 judges will be selected by the President. There are **13 categories** to be judged, in the event of a tie, the tie will be determined by the earliest manufacture date. **The judges' decision is final.**
4. Companies may enter more than one truck in each category of the show truck contest.
5. To **be scored on all categories** the doors, hood, and all compartments must be open. Judges can only judge what can be seen.
6. No score will be given for displays or exhibits on or near the truck being judged.
7. Anything placed on the ground will result in disqualification i.e.: **glitter**, etc.
8. Judging **forms must be readily accessible** to the judges. Please pick up your judging form, with entry number, from the ITWA registration booth and place judging forms on the seat or floor board for easy access prior to 11am on Saturday.

DOT CHAT WITH BRENT HOOVER



Hello and welcome back! If you are new to the column I would like to take a minute and bring you up to speed on who I am. My name is Brent Hoover. I am a Master Trooper with the Indiana State Police. I have started my 19th year with the ISP. I am assigned to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division or CVED for short. My primary daily duty is to enforce the State and Federal Regulations for CMVs in the State of Indiana. I am certified to complete Part A and B Inspections, as well as General Haz-mat and Cargo Tank inspections. I am also a Part B Instructor for the National Training Center, which means I teach new inspectors how to inspect and document Level 1 Inspections. I have competed twice in the North American Inspectors Championships. I am the current administrator of the CVED Facebook page where I post about tips and tricks to improve your pre-trip inspections and to avoid common roadside violations.

This month I would like to take a few minutes to discuss the exciting world of Wheel Fasteners!! Or as we commonly know them as lug nuts!!!



In the FMCSAR's 393.205 Wheels.

- (a) Wheels and rims shall not be cracked or broken.
- (b) Stud or bolt holes on the wheels shall not be elongated (out of round).
- (c) Nuts or bolts shall not be missing or loose.

So how many violations can you spot in this picture?

With two missing and several of the wheel fasteners loose would this be an Out of Service violation?

Check the guidance below to find out!

g. Wheel Fasteners

Loose, missing, broken, cracked or stripped wheel fasteners that are ineffective as follows: For 10 fastener positions - 3 anywhere or 2 adjacent; for 8 fastener positions or less - 2 anywhere (this applies to both spoke and disc wheels). (393.205 (c))

Please be safe and always check your lug nuts!
